RICK SQUIERS Camp Director



Rick Squiers will begin his twelfth season as head volleyball coach at UNK in the fall of 2010.

In his first eleven years, he has guided the Lopers to a 354-51 record, ten NCAA Tournament berths, seven RMAC regular season titles, three Elite Eight appearances and a national runner-up finish in 2005.

Squiers is a six-time RMAC Coach of the Year, as well as a three-time AVCA Southwest Region Coach of the Year. Prior to coming to UNK, Squiers led the volleyball program at Hastings, guiding the Broncos to a 206-59 record and three conference titles in six years.

In 20 years as a head coach at the collegiate and high school levels, Squiers has garnered Coach of the Year honors nine times while amassing a record of 661-188.

DOUG TABBERT Assistant Director



Coach Tabbert is entering his fourth season as the Lopers' top assistant. Coach Tabbert brings a wealth of expertise to UNK Volleyball Camps. Specializing in technical instruction, he has nine years of collegiate head coaching experience. He held recent posts at South Dakota School of Mines and Hastings College. Tabbert has worked volleyball camps throughout the country including regular stints at Pac 10 powers Stanford and Oregon.

NATASHA MARQUIS Assistant Director



Coach Marquis is entering her third season as the graduate assistant volleyball coach at UNK. A native of King City, California, she began her collegiate career at Butte College in California. At Butte, she helped the Roadrunners win back-to-back Golden Valley Conference titles. She went on to play for Division I Albany University where she helped the Great Danes win 44 matches in 2006 and 2007. Coach Marquis prepped at King City High and earned Female Athlete of the Year in 2004. A four-year volleyball letter winner, she helped the Mustangs win back-to-back conference titles while being a two-time all-conference selection.
